Hear from our Psychologist

Dr. Katie Franke works with children and families to address developmental concerns, especially autism, in Columbia, South Carolina. She spends time understanding family concerns, observing the child, and providing tailored supports to aid development.

Dr. Franke's passion for psychology began in undergrad when a family member was diagnosed with autism. Witnessing her family's search for answers inspired her to bridge gaps for children with autism. She started as a BT in a day school, fell in love with ABA, and pursued her doctorate in school psychology while earning her BCBA credentials. She completed her residency at Johns Hopkins, focusing on ABA interventions.

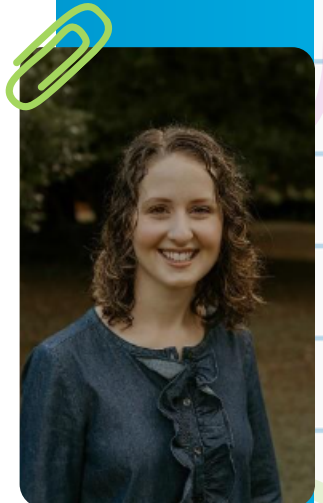
Why ABS Kids?

Dr. Franke values ABS Kids' emphasis on early intervention and thorough evaluations, ensuring families receive the right support.

Dr. Franke conducts detailed evaluations, seeing two patients daily. She gathers developmental and medical history, works directly with the child using tools like the ADOS-2, and provides actionable steps based on results.

Advice for Parents

If you have developmental concerns, talk to your pediatrician and consider tools like the M-CHAT. Increasing face-to-face interactions can benefit all children.





Hear from One of Our BCBA's: Conor Lumley

Conor develops procedures and tracks data to help clients build communication skills and independence. While he works directly with clients occasionally, he primarily supports technicians in implementing strategies and adjusting plans based on data.

With a background in psychology, Conor initially had reservations about ABA. He sought an ethical company and found ABS Kids, where he fell in love with the science. Starting as an RBT, he transitioned to the BCBA path through the ABS Kids LAUNCH program, which allowed him to balance work and coursework seamlessly.

Advice for New BTs

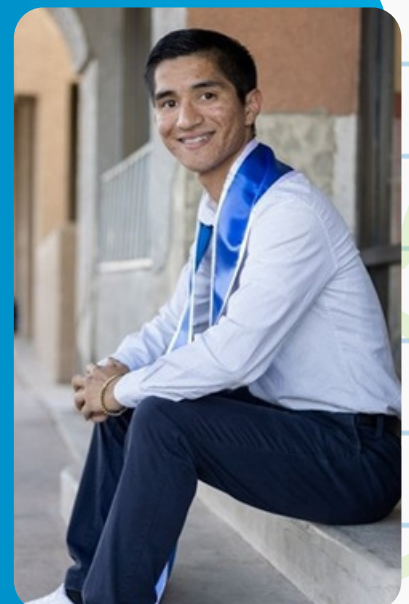
“Don’t stress about being perfect. Mistakes happen, but as long as you follow the ethics code and listen to your supervisor, you’re doing great!”

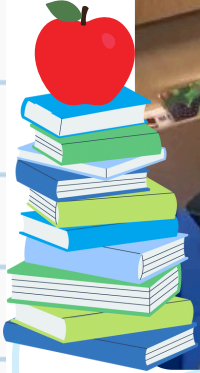
